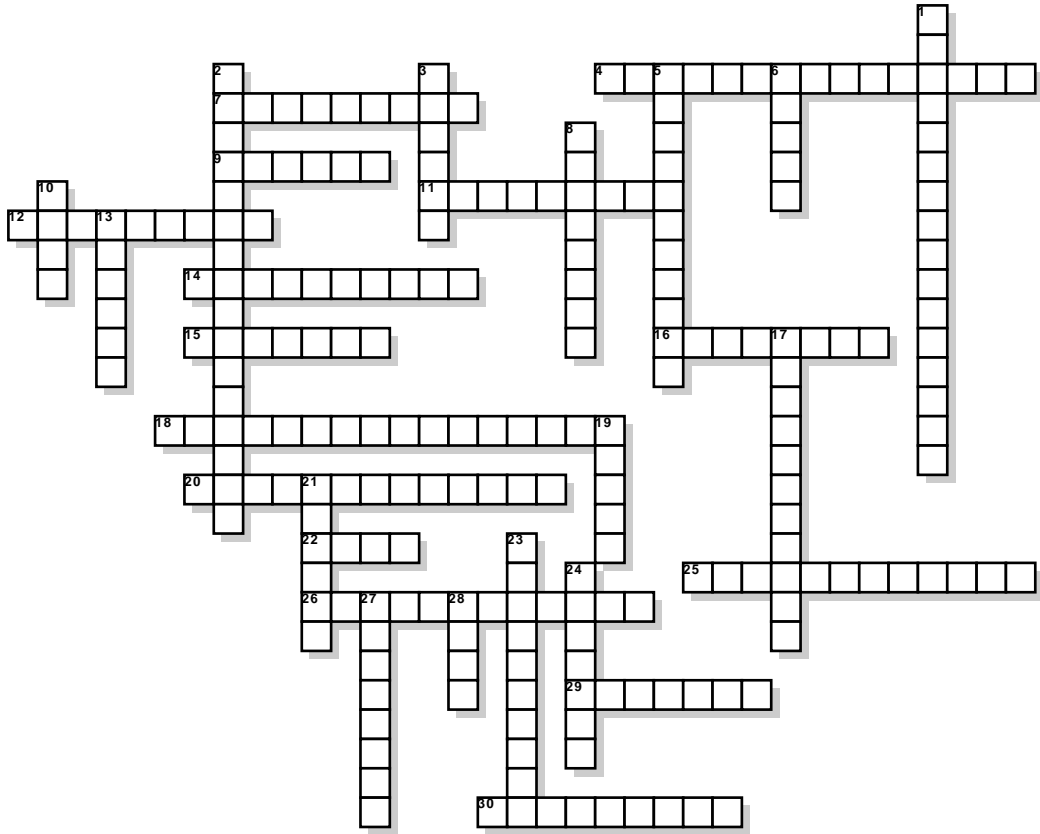


# Literary Terms
